

V. STATEMENT OF THE OBJECT OF THE APPLICATION

19. The object with the application is firstly to bring these various alleged violations of the Conventions to the attention of the Commission, in order that such violation can be rectified through the Court. Secondly, the matter is a question of principle for the Applicant, unless the Danish authority's methods can be held within the various international convention Denmark has signed, this must be condemned by the world, It is only possible for authorities outside Denmark to conduct a proper, impartial and unbiased investigation in order that some truth should come to light.

Denmark is a rather special country - a very small society which in many ways can be found the forerunners of the world and with many years of democratic traditions, when such country commit any violation of the Human Rights or other international conventions which it has ratified - it must be condemned, vigorously and as so much more deplorable.
